Visitors to The Hamlet

Covid update October 2021

The Hamlet continues to ensure that **our Hamlet Users are as safe as possible from Covid infection** while at The Hamlet. For this reason, the following apply from October until further notice:

1. All visitors are asked to follow our guidelines while they are on The Hamlet premises to protect our staff and Hamlet Users.
2. Visits should be booked in advance.
3. Visitors to The Hamlet premises and areas where we are working with Hamlet Users are required, to provide evidence of a negative Lateral Flow Test (LFT) upon arrival, (tests should be taken within 72hrs of the visit and to wear mask and other PPE as required, for the duration of the visit when they are walking around the site. If the visitor is unable to provide evidence of a LFT they will be asked to remain outside the building or a designated room and take a LFT test
4. When sitting in meetings, eating, and drinking, as long as there is social distance between people it is appropriate to remove masks/face coverings.
5. Visitors to the centres where there are no Hamlet Users on site do not have to wear a mask, unless they choose to and are not required to do a LFT but are expected to wipe down surfaces etc at the end of their time at The Hamlet.
6. Visits of less than 30 minutes to The Hive or The Den (Head Office) do not need to provide evidence of a LFT but they will need to wear PPE as required and provide evidence of double vaccination.
